










## **HOME ON THE WAVES**

The largest private residential yacht on Earth, **The World, Residences at Sea**, sails to Hawai'i in December where its residents will enjoy extended stays in five ports of call (Honolulu, Nawiliwili, Kahului, Kailua-Kona and Hilo) during its 10-day journey across the Aloha State. The sojourn is part of the ship's 2024 voyage to six continents including Antarctica, South and East Africa, South Asia, Indonesia, South Pacific and Australasia. Equipped with world-class amenities and state-of-the-art facilities, the mega yacht travels to approximately 100 ports of call a year, offering a unique

ultra-luxury lifestyle of global exploration that is internationally renowned for its journeys to many of the planet's most remote and undiscovered areas as well as to bustling cosmopolitan cities. Resident owners of this "floating city" travel for as long as they desire, spending an average of three to four months (combined) on board every year. The World's 165 residences range from expansive three-bedroom apartments to studios, privately owned by approximately 150 families from 20 countries around the world, with a small number available for resale.
